



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) of Intensive HKAR-66 Training

1. What is HKAR-66?

HKAR-66 is a set of requirements for the qualification of aircraft maintenance staff by Civil Aviation Department (CAD) for the issuance of an Aircraft Maintenance Licence. The HKAR-66 licence is a pre-requisite before the licence holder can be authorised by HKCAD, via a HKAR-145 Approved Maintenance Organisation, to release an aircraft to service after all maintenance works on the particular aircraft have been completed. 2. How can I apply for Intensive HKAR-66 Training?

3. How many modules of examination should I pass if I would like to acquire HKAR-66 basic licence before accumulating 5-years' relevant working experience?

Students have to pass 13 (Cat. B1.1) or 12 (Cat. B2*) HKAR-66 exam modules plus 4 essay questions by attending the HKAR-66 AML Exam at HKCAD facilities. We offer intensive training for 11 modules for Category B1.1/B2* and some extension course for Category B2*. Students may do self-study for Module 1-Mathematics and Module 2- Physics for the HKAR-66 examinations.

4. When will the HKAR-66 Aircraft Maintenance Licence (AML) Examination be held at HKCAD facilities?

5. Why do I have to attend Intensive HKAR-66 training before taking HKAR-66 examinations?

You will be provided with expertise advice on how to improve performance in the CAD exams and consultation on career development in aircraft maintenance sectors as well.

Certificate of Attendance will be issued to students upon satisfactory completion of a module (i.e. 90% attendance rate).
