### Remarks

1. This is a preliminary course of study of the dual degree programme. Students should the 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year at PolyU and the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year at UW by taking the subjects highlighted in the recommended progression pattern.
2. The dual degree programme consists of regular courses available at both universities and will be determined in consultation with academic advisors from PolyU and UW. If there is a necessity of changing a study pattern/subject, it will be agreed between PolyU and UW before the commencement of the academic mobility of a student.
3. Students should study the designated subjects which are credit transferable for the corresponding subjects between PolyU and UW. If they study the subjects other than the specified subjects, they will not be able to meet the graduation requirements of dual degree programme and complete the programme within the normal study period.
4. For the award of BA (Hons) in Social Policy and Social Entrepreneurship, students should take four designated programme-specific elective subjects and choose two CAR subjects, one from undergraduate curriculum and another from CAR M with CR/CW requirements.
  - a) Stream Electives (to take **three** designated subjects)
    - APSS328 Programme Planning and Evaluation (3 credits)
    - APSS4533 Health and Society (3 credits)
    - APSS4534 Housing Issues, Challenges and Solutions (3 credits)
  - b) Social Science Electives (to take **one** designated subject)
    - APSS348 Economics and Social Problems (3 credits)
  - c) CAR A Human Nature, Relations and Development (to choose **one** 3-credit subject from the undergraduate curriculum to make up the credits for APSS111/112 with double fulfillment in CAR A)
  - d) CAR M Chinese History and Culture (to choose **one** 3-credit subject with Chinese Reading/Writing Requirements from CAR M)
5. Students should enrol a Service-Learning subject in summer term of year one in order to lessen the study load in year four when they return to PolyU.
6. Students should seek advice from the Programme Leader and/or Academic Advisor at PolyU and/or UW if they come across any difficulties during the mobility period.
7. The department of Applied Social Sciences and the University of Warsaw reserves the right to offer the subjects in the semesters different from the above.
