The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Architectural and Associated Consultancy Services for Conversion of Multi-purpose Hall to Auditorium at Hung Hom Bay Campus (Tender Ref.: CDO2024/030) Invitation for Expression of Interest

The University is planning to convert the existing multi-purpose hall at 1/F of Hung Hom Bay Campus (HHB) to an auditorium. The estimated overall cost is approximately \$65M. The location plan is ... enclosed in <u>Appendix A</u> for information.

The project scope mainly involves the conversion of the existing multi-purpose hall at 1/F of Hung Hom Bay (HHB) Campus to an auditorium with a minimum capacity of 500 seats. This conversion will include all essential provisions to facilitate the application for Places of Public Entertainment (PPE) License for the future auditorium. The proposed floor area is about 2,000 sq.m. and the site work will tentatively commence in end of 2025.

The Architectural and Associated Consultancy Services should include multi-disciplinary consultancy services covering the following areas:

- Architectural services;
- Structural engineering;
- Building services engineering;
- AV/IT services;
- Acoustic consultancy services;
- Theatre design consultancy services; and
- Other related services to complete the project works.

Please advise if you will be interested in submitting the technical and fee proposals for the above by ... completing and returning the attached proforma in <u>Appendix B</u> with a list of ongoing and completed projects in similar nature (i.e. Theatre, auditorium and similar performing space), including the contract cost, scale, and the appointed acoustic / theater design consultants, to our office <u>on or before 12:00 noon 27 September 2024</u>. Non-compliance with the above listed submission may result in exclusion for the subsequent tender invitation.

You are also required to declare any involvement or interest if it is considered by you to be in real or apparent conflict with the duties to be performed for this consultancy. An involvement or interest declared would be carefully considered but would not automatically bar you from being further considered in the selection process.

The University is not bound to invite any consultants who have expressed interest to submit the technical and fee proposal.







The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Campus Development Office Disciplinary Action against Unsatisfactory Performance of Consultants

- 1. The Campus Development Office (CDO) will take disciplinary action against all consultants with unsatisfactory performance.
- 2. For consultant(s) with unsatisfactory performance, the Project-in-charge should issue verbal warning at the first time and the first notice of written warning# by Senior Project Manager and at the second time onwards to the consultant concerned to urge for their review and improvement.
- 3. The consultant(s) will be suspended from tendering exercise for six months after receiving the second notice of written warning#, and if the third notice of written warning# issued by Senior Project Manager is received, the consultant(s) would be suspended from tendering exercise for twelve months. The consultant(s) would be excluded in the next review for inclusion as the Office Consultant List would be reviewed once every two years. However, the consultant(s) may appeal to a Review Panel (consisting of Senior Project Manager and other senior staff member(s) such as Division Head appointed by the Director of Campus Development (DoCD). If the Panel is satisfied with the explanation given by the consultant(s), it may recommend to DoCD to cancel the penalty.
- 4. The consultants' performance for a consultancy agreement shall also be continuously assessed until the certificate of completion of works has been issued.
- 5. For the notice of written warning received as mentioned in item 2 and 3 above, it will be accumulated and counted across all projects in hand of the consultant(s) currently handled with The Hong Kong Polytechnic University.
