CEE Entry Scholarships for Outstanding EOSH Students

The Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering (CEE) accords recognition to outstanding students admitted to our undergraduate programmes via Non-JUPAS admission.

A one-off entry scholarship “CEE Entry Scholarship for Outstanding EOSH Students” will be granted to admittee(s) with outstanding academic results. Outstanding students who have attained the qualifications as stipulated below will be eligible for consideration of Entry Scholarships.

Programme

Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Environmental and Occupational Safety and Health [31470]

No. & Value:	Two scholarships of HK\$20,000 each in each academic year commencing from 2025/2026.
Eligibility:	To full-time <u>first-year</u> students admitted to Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Environmental and Occupational Safety and Health
Selection Criteria:	Based on academic result. The awardee should have attained a minimum award GPA of 3.8 during their previous study in Higher Diploma or Associate Degree in Science / Engineering / Safety or a relevant discipline.
Selection Procedures:	If there are more than two candidates fulfilling the abovementioned criteria and attaining the same academic result, if any, they are required to attend a selection interview conducted by CEE in person. <i>*Other things being equal, priority shall be given to the student who has financial needs.</i>
Remarks:	The scholarship will be disbursed by installments and the continuation is subject to satisfactory academic result.

Granting of the Award

The Department will identify outstanding admittee(s) and notify them of the award after the commencement of the academic year, no application is required.

Remarks:

1. Students must fulfil the **University’s General Entrance Requirements**.
2. If a student is eligible for more than one Entry Scholarships offered by the University, only **ONE scholarship with higher value** will be awarded.
3. A student can concurrently hold more than one scholarship administered by the University in an academic year if the total value of scholarships received by him/her **does not exceed his/her annual tuition fee payable plus HK\$50,000** unless otherwise stipulated.
