

CRRT Notice (159): Campus Access in Compliance With Vaccine Pass Requirements

Dear Colleagues and Students

As announced on 18 February 2022 via CRRT Notice (14), all staff, students, contractors and visitors must have completed vaccination for campus access in accordance with the Government's Vaccine Pass requirements, unless they are medically unfit for COVID 19 vaccination. We urge you to carefully review the dosage schedule (https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/vp_t1_ENG.pdf) to ensure compliance with the requirements.

Campus visitors and contractors are required to use the "LeaveHomeSafe" mobile app to scan venue QR codes and comply with the relevant requirements for campus access.

We take this opportunity to remind all members of the University, in particular new students and staff members, that the University will fully implement the Vaccine Pass requirements for the start of the new academic year. In this connection, colleagues and students must update personal vaccination records with supporting documents via the COVID-19 Vaccination Status Reporting Portal (<https://cvsr.polyu.edu.hk/hdms/>) as soon as possible. The information will facilitate your campus access through entrance turnstiles with student/staff ID cards. Those who are medically unfit for vaccination must undergo regular weekly PCR tests and report negative test results via the same portal for continued campus access. Test results for those successfully applied for university PCR testing will be automatically sent to the portal and no separate uploading is required. Any submission or usage of falsified information/records will be handled according to the University's established mechanism and may be subject to disciplinary action.

Students should refer to the University Notices for Students for the latest learning, teaching and assessment (LTA) arrangements for Semester One of 2022/23. If individual new students have genuine difficulty returning to campus due to Vaccine Pass requirements, they may approach their host departments to explore the possibility of alternative arrangements.
