Dear Students and Colleagues

Having reviewed the current pandemic situation, the University would like to inform you of the following Learning and Teaching arrangements for the rest of Semester Two of 2021/22:

(A) Learning and Teaching Arrangements

General learning and teaching activities

The prevailing hybrid mode will be extended to 6 February 2022 (i.e. end of the Lunar New Year break). If the HKSAR government advises the public by 6 February 2022 that the pandemic situation continues to stabilize, the University will resume full face-to-face (f2f) learning and teaching starting from 7 February 2022, of which you will be notified by the close of the Lunar New Year break. Students shall attend general learning and teaching activities in person on campus when f2f teaching resumes.

Essential learning and teaching activities

Essential learning and teaching remains unchanged, i.e., these activities will continue to be conducted f2f, with stepped up social distancing measures and carefully evaluated and actionable precautionary plans as arranged by the subject offering departments.
