Musicals are a popular form of theatrical performance comprising songs, acting, dance and spoken dialogue. The lyrics of a musical, sometimes lyrical, sometimes narrative, can be elegant or colloquial in tone. Intended to entertain, they are so well and deftly written that they can be considered fine literature. In this workshop, you will be awestruck by beauty and intricacies of musical lyrics as you will get the chance to study some of the finest pieces and to compose your own lyrics.

Mr Chris Shum is a leading figure in musical and theatrical lyrics; he has won the Best Original Music Award twice in the Hong Kong Drama Awards and Best Original Film Song in the 43rd Taiwan Golden Horse Awards. In 2013, he received the Best Original Film Song award for his lyrics for Ding Feng Bo, the theme song of The Last Tycoon, in the 32nd Hong Kong Film Awards
