Ceramics can be shaped by a range of methods; the most common ways are hand-building and wheel throwing. Participants can try out both methods, mould the shape with tools, make the accessories and learn how to decorate their works with glaze in this workshop. The tutor will also share her insights on appreciating ceramics.

Ms Aidan Wong is a local ceramic artist who has over 30 years' experience in ceramic art. Her work Fountain was selected for the 14th Hong Kong Art Biennial Exhibition and is now part of the permanent collection of the Hong Kong Museum of Art.
