Mr Choi Hoi-ying is a renowned contemporary ink painter. His works won the Urban Council Fine Arts Award in the Contemporary Hong Kong Art Biennial, the award of Kunststation Kleinsassen Gallery Liebau from Germany and other awards from America, Europe and Asia. Mr Choi's works are collected by local institutions including the Hong Kong Museum of Art.
