Originating in the Renaissance period, italic calligraphy is a typography that is well known for its slightly forward-slanting characters, and many of its letters can be completed in a single stroke. It is a classic and tasteful hand which had a profound influence over the later development of Latin script. Mr Patrick Leung will cover the fundamentals of italic calligraphy and teach participants the necessary skills to write in it.

Mr Patrick Leung, celebrated for his stylish handwriting, is a graphic designer and calligrapher based in Hong Kong. He has collaborated with various international fashion brands. He founded the Hong Kong Lettering Arts Club in 1999 and published his own book *Western Calligraphy by Chinese Hand* in 2008.
