

Turkish Mosaic Lamp Workshop (Electronic Candle Holder) 土耳其馬賽克燈工作坊（電子燭台）



Mosaic art has developed into a popular craft that is not limited to professionals. Participants can easily follow the instructions and create their own artworks using a diverse range of materials. It can also be used as an art therapy, in which the participant's stress is relieved by a concentration on the creative process.

Born and raised in Hong Kong, Ms Christine Lee has been interested in the Middle East since secondary school. While she was doing her Bachelor of Arts in Hong Kong a few years ago, she lived in Istanbul for half a year. Since then she has built strong connections with Turkey. After obtaining her Master of Arts in Middle East Studies, she met the two co-founders of the Mosaic Art Studio, and she became the first local mosaic lamp instructor in Hong Kong.
