Since the commencement of Season 14 in 2021, JCDISI has reaped systemic change within and beyond small group homes (SGH)! We are gradually closing the service gap for aged-out residents of SGH by connecting 'Hongkong Land HOME FUND' with social enterprise 'Light Be' to set up "Youth Light Home", short-term rental units with catered personal development plan for post-18 SGH residents and other youth from underprivileged families to support their transition to independent living as an adult and acquiring a self-sufficient lifestyle.

The 'Furniture For Our Future – For Families in Sub-divided Units' press conference was successfully held in late November to celebrate success of cross-sector efforts. The project has received widespread news coverages, including in local TV programmes, RTHK's 'Hong Kong United' and TVB's 'A Dream Home Planning'.

The furniture distribution campaign is also in full swing. Apart from the pilot run in Kowloon City, we are now partnering with multiple NGOs in Yau Tsim Mong and Sham Shui Po to deliver another 720 furniture sets to families in need and will also be setting foot in Kwai Tsing, Tsuen Wan and some other districts.

### JCDISI Research Project's Effort Recognised in 2022 CIC Construction Innovation Award

Led by the JCDISI's Spatial (Research) Team, the research on "Expandable Housing by MiC" was presented with the Merit Award in the category of "Construction Sustainability" of the "2022 CIC Construction Innovation Award".

A design prototype based on Modular Integrated Construction (MiC) technology was proposed in the research to design a building system that enable the structure to be flexibly disassembled or reassembled, with a view to deliver housing in a speedy and systematic manner.

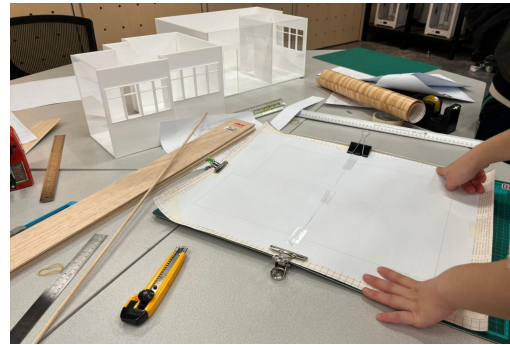
#### Season 15: Shaping Dementia Care Culture | Movie Screening and Online Seminar
