# Workshop Join us to be the Innovator of Education

In the past 3 years, JCDISI carried out a series of learning and teaching experiments among Hong Kong secondary schools through SoInno Design Education programme. We are dedicated in incorporating Design Thinking and Social Innovation into the curriculum, which held 154 student workshops, 20 train-the-trainer workshops; and developed 27 interactive learning and teaching tools with the participating schools.

In the next phase, we will also be focusing on equipping educators with the knowledge and skills of implementing student-centred education innovation projects. Stay tuned!

### Study

#### Intervention Study on Sub-divided Units' furniture solution

The first intervention study of the Action Project "Co-designing Child-friendly Furniture" has been conducting in the selected subdivided units this summer! The pre-and-post study design will help verify the validity of the prototyped furniture on children's posture and eye health improvement. The baseline study has kick-started in mid-July, where children are asked to complete a set of school-related tasks (writing, typing, watching tutorials, etc.) using their existing furniture. The post-intervention study will soon begin in mid-August. Stay tuned!
