Participant Feedback for Introduction to University Teaching (IUT2.0)

The followings are direct quotations extracted from the end-of-programme surveys collected from participants who completed the IUT2.0 programme.

During the online learning period.....

- *“The idea of using the Discussion Forum in the Blackboard of this programme is very useful, I also used in my course, the students participate in the discussion very actively”*
- *“I have used the polling in my online class to engage with students and it seems the reponses are quite active. Meanwhile, to wait for the late comers, I have tried to explain the general ideas of the course, and background information about me. I even shared some warming-up videos related to the course to attract students' attention”*
- *“i think the platform is useful in developing different learning activities with students”*
- *“Some online modules are self-paced, allowing flexibility to complete. The teaching practice is good, as we could receive individual comments and learn from each other”*

From Semester 2, 2019-20

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- *“(IUT2.0 demonstrated) Use of different online tools like Zoom for tutorials, Ultra for lecture: makes online classroom interactive with tools embedded in the program like whiteboard, poll, etc.”*
- *“Engage students in classes. I have used poll and asked questions during lectures to engage students in on-line lectures. It's very good and students are very enthusiastic”*
- *“To engage the students during the class, I have use the shared whiteboard function, polling and short videos, breakout rooms for small group discussion (Zoom). They are good tools to engage students. The response is much better than in face to face class. One drawback is that I cannot see students' faces during the class”*
- *“I use polling to learn the background of the students and then decide the learning scope, which is quite good”*
- *“I learn how to use many functions in blackboard, which is very useful for me”*
- *“Strategies: get to know how to teach by using Collaborate, get to know various online tools for teaching”*
- *“As a student, it provides flexibility of own learning schedule. There is no physical limitation in attending class as long as the network is working well. As a teacher, the platform is most useful and convenient in announcement of information and sending teaching contents to students. Online teaching is feasible and students are more fond of asking questions through chat box that they might not ask in normal face to face class; sometimes there are too many questions that came in and not enough time to handle during the class . Assessment through online platform can be useful particular during special period like the COV19 situation, but at risk of plagiarism”*
- *“It is well designed and multi-functional. It facilitates teaching in multiple approaches”*

- *“I guess in this pandemic the LMS has become the essential platform of learning and teaching, no doubt about it. It would highlight the importance of a solid content heuristics and information architecture for navigating this online environment....”*

During the hybrid teaching period.....

Challenges I have faced:

- *"To control the classroom both online and face to face. \nTo answer students online while I was still taking to my face to face students. \nTo ensure the online students still get what I did for my demonstration in the classroom and switching the devices but I might forget to unmute and mute the mic"*

- *"I like the program because I was able to meet new colleagues who are also interested in improving teaching skills. I also enjoyed learning from the instructors the useful tips in performing hybrid teaching"*

- *"Thank you . \n \nI tried to list out the learning objectives as suggested in the beginning of the lecture. and set up ground rules for the class. \n \nBy use of wider variety of teaching means eg: polling/ video... helps engage students to class \n \n"*

During blended learning

- *“The discussion and grading system is useful making teaching effective”*

C. Students can build, maintain, and strengthen networks through LMS on the Blackboard. 2) As a teacher, I think those people may want to use an LMS in their own teaching: Teachers and teaching assistants who want to more effectively make use of time to teach and share more things after class, solve students’ problems and gain their feedback in time, build networks and interact more with students”*
