Abstract

Additionally, insights on integrating international experiences into one's academic profile to enhance visibility and impact within their field will be discussed. This seminar is designed for doctoral students looking to leverage opportunities in the UK for professional growth and to establish a distinguished presence in the UK academic community.

Prof. Wing Lam is a Professor of Organisational Psychology at the University of Manchester and a Research Fellow at the University of Cambridge. She serves as a panel member on the staffing committee of the OB group and was the Postgraduate Research Director at the School from 2021 to 2023. Prior to joining the school, she worked at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University. In 2023, she was honored as an Outstanding Scholarly Alumni by the Faculty of Business and Department of Management and Marketing at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University. Her research focuses on employee proactivity, the dark side of leadership, and team dynamics. She is currently the Associate Editor for the *Journal of Occupational and Organizational Psychology* and was the Associate Editor for the *Journal of Business Research* from 2016 to 2023. Her research has been published in the *Academy of Management Journal, Journal of Applied Psychology, Personnel Psychology, Organizational Behavior* and *Human Resource Management, Leadership Quarterly*, and other journals.
