VALID Travelling Documents

Valid for more than **6 months** from the date of return

HK Students

- Hong Kong ID Card (香港身分證)
- **Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macau Residents (回鄉證)**
- Passport (護照)

Mainland Students

- Exit-Entry Permit for Travelling to and from Hong Kong and Macau (往來港澳通行證)
- Resident Identity Card (中國居民身份證)
- **Passport (護照)**

International Students

- Passport
- **Visa (if required, i.e. China Visa)**

For Who?

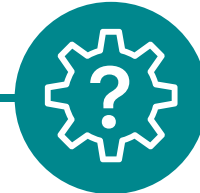
All full-time undergraduate students enrolled in a non-local CAR/SL subjects



For What?

All travel expenses:

- Air ticket
- Room and board
- Transportation
- Outbound Activity
- Other relevant travel and subject-related expenses



How to apply?

No need to apply. **Automatically applied** towards your travel expenses in your non-local CAR/SL subjects, for up to two subjects.



Do I need to pay?

Upon registration, you need to pay an **Outbound Activity Fee** to secure your place and cover your expenses exceeding the study fund.

The amount of each subject will be announced on eStudent. **Unspent balance will be refunded.**



NON-LOCAL STUDY FUND

HK\$10,000 per student during their studies at PolyU for taking **non-local CAR** or SL subjects, for up to **two** subjects.

EXAMPLE - AAE1BN01V Introduction to Aviation Industry (HK\$3,000 Outbound Activity Fee)

Scenario 1

Total subject expense = \$9,000
→ 1st: \$3,000 refund
→ 2nd: \$4,000 + account balance refund

OAF

1st: \$3,000
2nd: \$13,000

Scenario 2

Total subject expense = \$11,000
→ 1st: \$2,000 refund
→ 2nd: \$2,000 + account balance refund

Scenario 3

Total subject expense = \$13,000
→ 1st: No refund
→ 2nd: Account balance refund
