

Department of Land Surveying & Geo-Informatics Scholarship for Hall Residents

The above Scholarship donated by the Department of Land Surveying & Geo-Informatics (LSGI) is now open for application. Details are as follows:

Qualification:

Current full-time local/non-local degree students* of LSGI.

(*Students with accommodation expenses in the Student Halls of Residence in 2024/25 covered by entry/post-entry scholarship(s) are not eligible to apply.)

Number and Value:

A scholarship of HK\$6,000.

Selection Criteria:

- The applicants should have obtained a minimum semester GPA of 3.2 in the first semester of 2024/25.
- They should also have resided in the Student Halls of Residence in the first semester of 2024/25 and will continue to reside in the Hall in the **whole second semester** of 2024/25. *Otherwise, the successful applicants are required to refund the scholarship money to the Donor via the Student Affairs Office (SAO).*
- Other aspects of the applicants such as involvement in extra-curricular activities (including hall activities) and/or community services as well as financial need will also be taken into consideration.
- The disciplinary record(s) of the candidates with PolyU (if any) may be taken into consideration in the processing of applications.

The selection will be done by the Head of LSGI in consultation with the staff of the Department, the decision of which is final. Selection interview may be required when necessary. Selection results will be released sometime by end April 2025.

Application Deadline & Enquiry:

Completed application form with supporting documents should be submitted to Student Affairs Office (SAO) via SAO's [Scholarship Application System](#) on or before 23.59 pm on **16 February 2025 (Sunday)**.
