

# Dual PhD Degree Programme in Fashion and Textiles (for existing PhD students in SFT of PolyU)

The School of Fashion and Textiles (SFT) at The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) announces a collaboration with the Department of Fashion and Textiles, Seoul National University (SNU) to offer a Dual PhD Degree Programme (the Programme) in Fashion and Textiles. This unique opportunity allows research postgraduate students to enroll in a PhD programme at both universities and undertake research activities at both institutions.

## Programme Highlights

- Upon successful completion of the Programme, students will receive two award parchments, one issued by PolyU and the other by SNU.
- The Programme is open to eligible applicants at PolyU and SNU, with a limited number of quota annually from each university.

## Admission Requirements

Prospective students of the Programme will be recruited jointly by PolyU and SNU and must meet the admission requirements of Seoul National University. For details, please refer to admission requirements below:

## Study Period and Arrangement

The normal period of study is four years.

Students shall spend first two years at PolyU (Home University) to complete the required coursework and research work, and then shall spend the rest of their time at SNU (Host University).

Students are required to commence their studies at SNU after fulfilling the residence requirement of PolyU.

Details on the residence requirements in PolyU can be found in [Appendix 1](#) of the Research Postgraduate Student Handbook. Please take the residence requirement into consideration when preparing the study plan.

## Financial Support and Student Services

- Students may receive financial assistance during their stay at SNU (Host University), subject to funding availability.
- Students are required to pay the annual tuition fees to PolyU during their studies at SNU. Stipends will be temporarily suspended while outgoing students are based at SNU.
- Students may use the Conference Grant provided by PolyU during their studies at SNU.
- Visa (if applicable) and accommodation arrangements will be made by the applicants.
- Students will be treated identically to regular research students in terms of student support services provided by the university.
