

SUSTAINABLE FASHION COLLECTIONS MANAGER (FREELANCE)

Redress is looking for a Sustainable Fashion Collections Manager (Freelance) to join its Events/Production team to work on the organisation of the Redress Design Award 2022, including but not limited to: fashion show, fashion photoshoots, exhibition. This position reports to the Events Director.

The Sustainable Fashion Collections Manager (Freelance) role includes:

General

- You are responsible for the documenting, organising, care, transport, and security of the Redress Design Award 2022 finalists and alumni garments pre, during, and post events.
- You will assist the Production Team with various tasks as and when needed, for the successful planning and execution of the Grand Final Fashion Presentation and all related events, including but not limited to photo shoots, filming activities, fittings, and rehearsals.

Receiving/documenting garments to Hong Kong

- Assist Production team with tracking and receiving garments arriving by courier from all around the world
- Review and familiarise with 50 outfits from emerging designers
- Unpack, sort, assemble, check, and photograph all garments
- Insert images and descriptions into summary document
- Communicate any garment damage or issues to the designers via the Redress team
- Pack clothes for events and organise transport to designated locations

Photo shoots

- Assist with the transportation of garments to and from shoot location
- Attend photoshoots, steam and hang clothing, assist with dressing models if needed
- Collect, check, and repack garments after events for storage in warehouse

Model Casting / Fittings / Fixing

 Bring selection of garments and assist with dressing models as needed at casting

Grand Final Fashion Presentation and exhibition

- Make sure the garments are all transported to the location, steamed and dressed on models and mannequins with support of production agency
- Assist on exhibition set up
- Assist backstage during show

REQUIRED SKILLS & DESIRED PROFILE:

- Eligible to live and work in Hong Kong
- Excellent command in both spoken and written English and Cantonese
- A passion for environmental sustainability and fashion
- High-energy, positive individual who takes initiative
- Excellent time management and organisational skills with the ability to work under pressure and manage competing priorities
- Resourceful, creative thinker
- Willing to accept a high workload at certain times
- PowerPoint knowledge
- Previous fashion design experience is a plus



WORK ARRANGEMENT
