This person will join the Circular Fashion Programme team to achieve our programme mission to reduce clothing waste entering Hong Kong's landfills by increasing the reuse, resale and recycling of clothing locally. You will mainly be supporting the Circular Fashion Programme team on planning, managing and creating content for the social media account of our secondhand clothing shop, The Redress Closet. You will also need to support the day-to-day operations of The Redress Closet with our shop staff.

Volunteer Period: 6 months from September 2022 onwards

Weekly Time Commitment: A minimum of 2 days per week, which can be arranged to fit your existing commitments.

Location: Hybrid remote/in-person including working at Redress' Sham Shui Po office/shop, event locations and your home. (This is subject to change depending on the Covid-19 situation and Redress' current policy at the time of your internship.).
