This person will join the Circular Fashion Programme team to achieve our programme mission to reduce clothing waste entering Hong Kong's landfills by increasing the reuse, resale and recycling of clothing locally. You will mainly be reporting to the Circular Fashion Programme Manager and working with the schools team in the outreach, organisation and delivery of our education activities targeting both local and international schools.

DETAILS OF THE POSITION

Volunteer Period: 12 weeks between September - December 2022

Weekly Time Commitment: A minimum of 2 days per week, which can be flexibly arranged depending on your other commitments

Location: Hybrid remote/in-person including working at Redress' Sham Shui Po office, event locations and your home. (This is subject to change depending on the Covid-19 situation and Redress' current policy at the time of your internship.).
