How will the programme help you excel?

The D.HTM attracts a range of professionals from industry and academia who are seeking to enhance their careers

Many of our students are full-time university lecturers and senior industry executives who study in a mixed-mode format, i.e., part-time, full-time or a combination of the two

Our classes are offered in block-release mode to accommodate the schedules of students who are unable to leave their full-time employment to pursue their studies

Small classes encourage dynamic interactions between students and close collaboration between students and faculty members

Taught in English, the programme is specifically geared towards developing students' professional competence to an advanced level

How will you progress in your studies?

You must complete one academic integrity and ethics subject, five compulsory subjects, two subjects from specialism streams and two elective subjects.

You will also produce a thesis consisting of two parts, a proposal for the thesis and the formal thesis. Alternatively, if you have a strong research background, you may choose the "Research Publications" option. In the latter case, you will be required to publish two fully refereed, thematically related papers as the first author.

You must also attend two residential schools, one of which will involve an overseas study tour as part of the Asian Paradigm in Hospitality Management course.

What does the application process involve?

You must have

- an MSc in Hotel and Tourism Management or equivalent; and
- a minimum of 1 year of teaching experience plus at least 1 year of industry experience at the supervisory or managerial level; or
- substantial (normally at least 3 years) industry experience at the supervisory or managerial level; or
- substantial (normally at least 3 years) teaching experience.

Applicants who are non-native English speakers, or whose Bachelor's or Master's degree was awarded by an institution where the medium of instruction is not English, must provide their TOEFL/IELTS score.

You will need

- a self-recommendation letter;
- a Master's degree graduation certificate;
- copies of transcripts from all colleges and universities attended;
- proof of past and current employment; and
- · one letter of recommendation.
