About the Course

Service-Learning (SL) is an experiential learning approach that combines community service with academic study and reflection to nurture students' empathy and social responsibility.

This course is tailored for educators and practitioners at the higher education level. Face-to-face components will be held in **Manila**, the Philippines, from 6-10 January 2025.

A PolyU Continuing Education certificate will be awarded upon satisfactory completion of the course.
