They will, based on the concept of universal design, advise the disadvantaged groups such as the elderly and low-income families/individuals living in private or subsidized buildings on how to enhance home safety and improve home environment. With the service recipients' consent, students will also carry out minor improvement works/small renovations such as hand drilling, fixing, plastering and painting to bring immediate benefits to them. Students will also introduce the available assistance schemes for medium- scale renovation and maintenance works under the home renovation hardship grant and interest-free loan to low-income families/individuals, as well as the building maintenance grant scheme to the elderly owners.
