What will students do to serve?	Students will be asked to deliver IT lessons/workshops to local students in primary/secondary schools or children in orphanages/community centres. During the service trip, the students are expected to spend 10 to 14 days and be divided into teams to conduct the workshops. The IT workshops will include mini-lectures, tutorial exercises, and hands-on practice. Students will be responsible for teaching different parts of the workshops. They will take turns to teach, and all students will contribute to teaching some parts. While one student is taking the role of a teacher, the other students will take the role of teaching assistants to assist the hands-on practice during the IT workshops. The service recipients will learn and practice different IT skills throughout the service period.
