What will students do to serve?	<p>Students will help primary students who are suffering from reading difficulties and their caretakers referred by NGOs and schools to improve their reading abilities. Examples of activities areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assisting speech therapists in conducting evaluation session and data analysis</li> <li>• Leading various group activities, educational programme and conducting post – treatment probe test under supervision of speech therapists and social workers</li> <li>• Conducting revision sessions with children and caregivers to consolidate what they have learnt during the programme</li> <li>• Having phone contacts with caregivers regularly to monitor children’s progress and their home practice, report their post-treatment evaluation results and give recommendation with the guidance of speech therapists and social workers</li> </ul>
