What will students do to serve?	For Group 101, the service project in 2024 Semester 1 will promote social integration among PolyU students, primary school students and the elderly. They will join hands to participate in a half-day competition (like Mario Balloon Battle <a href="https://polyu.hk/IGcng">https://polyu.hk/IGcng</a> ). PolyU students will work in groups to organise 4-day STEM workshops for teaching primary school students to build robotic cars by using Micro:bit, writing MakeCode program (Drag and Drop programming) and making DIY controllers. The elderly will also participate in the workshop to learn about health information and test the robotic cars. The final completion will be held on 8 Jan 2025.  For Group 102N, the same competition mentioned above will be held in Surat Thani, Thailand. PolyU students will join hands with international students in Thailand to organise 5-day STEM workshops for underprivileged children.
